Traffic Calming Update

After over 10 months of outreach to the residents of Huntley Hills, the neighborhood Traffic Calming Committee (under the HHNA) has developed a proposed traffic-calming plan. The plan is a reflection of 7 neighborhood meetings (including a meeting on April 28th, publicized by a neighborhood-wide mailing), dozens of Committee meetings and numerous e-mail updates to the HH news group. The resulting discussions and debates (with the County and with just about every neighbor they could find) led to many different iterations of the proposed plan, as feedback from neighbors was integrated into the plan.

The Committee will be presenting the proposed traffic-calming plan to the neighborhood on **September 15th at 7pm at Chamblee United Methodist Church**. This will provide you with another opportunity to ask any questions and comment on the plan. If no further changes are in order, DeKalb County will present our plan to the Board of Commissioners for vote on September 22nd. If the Commissioners approve the plan, we will then have 90 days to get 65% of homeowners in the affected area to sign a "yes" petition.

Annexation Update:

According to conversations with State Rep. Fran Millar, his legislative staff has prepared a Chamblee Annexation resolution for the 2010 legislative session. The resolution will first be introduced to the delegation of DeKalb State Senators and Representative. Since it is not a large area and is supported by many of the residents in the impacted area, it is likely to get their support. Once passed by the delegation, approval by the whole assembly is a mere formality as issues involving local matters are usually approved base on the delegations recommendation. Therefore, passage by the DeKalb delegation is the last big step before the people get the right to vote for annexation into the City of Chamblee.

The proposed annexation will encompass the areas inside Chamblee Dunwoody Rd to I-285 around to the City of Doraville (Lexus Dealership) then along Peachtree Rd (south of the GM plant) back to the existing city limits. Effectively, this will bring all of Huntley Hills, Gainsborough East, Savoy Rd, Chamblee Methodist Church, and the remaining stretch of Peachtree Ind. Blvd up to I-285 into the city of Chamblee.

A town hall meeting is in the works for November/December.
