## NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH REPORT:

First, I would like to thank our City of Chamblee and our Police Department for their dedication to our welfare. They have made such a dramatic improvement in the safety and the appearance of our neighborhood. I personally have lived in Huntley Hills since 1971 and never known us to have a better neighborhood than we have now.

Little by little more and more neighbors are becoming active in the Neighborhood Watch Program. I would encourage every resident to contact their Block Captain and become personally connected to the other neighbors in their Block Section.

Our neighborhood is divided into 58 sections. Forty-five of those sections have Block Captains, leaving 13 sections that need a neighbor to become a Block Captain. Those sections are: Admiral (3873-3906 and 3909-3943), Captain (3826-3880), Carlton (3841-3898), Commodore (4090-4112 and 41742-4238), Commodore Court (1990-1999), Ensign (3808-3868), Greenhill (3771-3813), Longview (3962-4024), Plantation (1946-2018 and 2114-2148), and Seaman Circle (2049-2103). The primary responsibility of a Block Captain is to assemble the contact information for all residents in his or her Section and to keep that information current.

Your Neighborhood Watch Program held a very successful general information meeting with the Chamblee Police Department January 25th. Residents from throughout the newly annexed area of the City also attended. About 150 were there where tons of questions were asked and answered.

Warm weather is just around the corner giving us an opportunity to say hello to our neighbors we know and introduce ourselves to those we haven't yet met. Make this Spring a time to get to know your neighbor time.
